We are gearing up for the Western Art Show which runs during Cowboy Poetry Week here in St. Anthony. We will begin accepting artwork for the show on Monday, March 28th. Artists are invited to submit up to 5 pieces of artwork (more if small works, fine crafts, custom jewelry, etc.) for exhibition in the Western Art Show. Space permitting, every artist's work will be included. All mediums are acceptable, including assemblages. Two dimensional artwork must be wired to hang. Maximum size (including frame) is 5 ft. high by 6 ft. wide, however, smaller pieces are preferred. To submit artwork, please read and sign the Exhibition Application and the Liability Waiver/Sales Agreement (attached).

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per piece

(contact us if submitting more than 5 pieces).

Drop off date: Mon., March 28th – Sat., April 9th

Pickup date: Saturday, May 14th - Tuesday, June 14th

Opening Reception: Thursday, April 14th, 5pm – 9pm

Show Dates: Thursday, April 14th - Saturday, May 14th

We are continuing to work on the art center. As soon as we are able to acquire the sheetrock (52 sheets) the Saint Anthony Work Camp is ready to continue offering their community service to do the labor to install it. Feel free to drop in and use the project tables, easels and drafting table (free). We are still organizing ceramic molds (~800 more molds to go) and need to install a sink before the ceramic/pottery studio is up and running. If you haven't dropped in, please do.

The artwork is beautiful and the art center tour will surprise you wish how much we are planning to offer.
