About the Workshop: Do you get bogged down halfway through your painting and wonder why it begins to fall apart? This workshop will take you through a simple process of distilling shapes and values to create a strong foundation for your painting. The demonstrations will be in pastel but oils and acrylics can also be used if you have messed around with them before this class. I will take you step by step through an easy process you can use with any medium to keep your shapes and values strong, creating a clear roadmap you can follow to the end of your painting.

Ages: 16 and up, all abilities

Instructor: Carolyn Caldwell

Materials: Bring your own supplies, including pastels (or oils and acrylics), pastel paper or board and paper towels or an old cloth. You may also wish to bring fixative. Canson Mi-Teintes Pastel Paper is available at the Lab for about \$2.55/19 x 25 inch sheet.

Artists are invited to submit up to 5 pieces of artwork (more if small works, fine crafts, custom jewelry, etc.) for this art show. Space permitting, every entry will be included. All mediums are acceptable, including assemblages. Two dimensional artwork must be wired, ready to hang, with a frame or wrapped canvas (no side staples). Maximum size (including frame) is 5 ft. high

by 6 ft. wide, however, smaller pieces are preferred.

Themes:

The Hodgepodge: Fine artists, this is your chance to bring us anything you wish to show (family friendly). NO THEME.

The Grim Museum: This is a fun show for artists and aspiring artists. It will exhibit outside the gallery, highlighting anything Halloween themed.

To submit artwork: Please read and sign the Exhibition Application and the Liability Waiver/Sales Agreement ([download](#)) and bring artwork in during the Drop off dates (below).

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per piece or volunteer for one hour per piece. Contact us if submitting more than 5 pieces. No entry fee for K - 12 student artwork which will appear on our Aspiring Artists wall.
